

2021-2022 College Scholarship Information

Awards Available

Three \$1000 scholarships will be awarded in 2021.

Qualifications

To apply for this scholarship, students must:

- Be enrolled full-time (at least 12 credit hours) at a 2- or 4-year college or university for the 2020-2021 academic year.
- Be a Catholic student attending Grand Valley State University OR a parishioner at St. Luke University Parish attending another college/university.

Ideal candidates will also:

- Demonstrate academic talent.
- Demonstrate community and/or faith involvement, leadership, and devotion.

Additionally, financial need may be taken into consideration for decisions between similarly qualified candidates.

Application

The following items are required for an application:

- 1. Completed application form
- 2. Personal statement/essay (see application form for details)
- 3. A sealed letter of recommendation from someone who can speak to your faith life and/or community service involvement.
 - a. To ensure fairness, **recommendations** from the following sources will not be accepted:
 - i. An immediate relative of the applicant
 - ii. A member of the Knights of Columbus Council #14586 who is on the selection committee
 - A current or former member of the clergy who served at St. Luke's. (This refers to clergy who are/were permanently assigned to ministry at St. Luke's. Seminarians, residents, clergy who previously attended GVSU or were parishioners at St. Luke's, etc. are acceptable.)
- 4. An official high school and/or college transcript
- 5. Copy of page 1 of the FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR)

All personal information will be kept confidential and will be available only to the scholarship decision committee.



Submission and Deadline

Completed applications and supporting documents must be **received** no later than 7:00 PM on Sunday, April 25, 2020. No exceptions can be made to this deadline.
